## Overview

He also has experience in the areas of debtor/creditor and bankruptcy litigation, construction litigation, real estate and land use litigation, health care litigation, employment litigation, accounting malpractice and insurance coverage litigation.

In 1993 and 1994, Nick served as Special Assistant District Attorney in Suffolk County. He has extensive trial experience in state and federal courts.

### Experience

- Represented minority shareholder of pharmaceutical company in a breach of fiduciary duty and Wage Act claim against majority shareholder. Obtained a judgment of over \$4.8 million after a three-week jury trial in the Business Litigation session of the Massachusetts Superior Court.
- Lead trial counsel to creditors committee in bankruptcy adversary proceeding challenging secured party claims and the validity and enforceability of liens. Amount in controversy exceeded \$550 million.
- Obtained federal court dismissal of claim against international law firm alleging that the law firm aided and abetted a Ponzi scheme.
